

# Philanthropy Chair Expectations

## First 30 Days

- Meet With: Past Philanthropy Chair, Archon, Chapter Advisor, Volunteer Relationship organization
- Submit any fundraising left behind from previous philanthropy chair

## Weekly

- Have a conversation with at least one brother about philanthropy to get feedback about your role, spark more involvement, and better understand people's motivations and view on philanthropy.
- Meet with a philanthropy committee of 3-6 brothers to strategize
- Check email, texts, and/or voicemail from Regional Director
- Keep track of chapter volunteer hours
- Update your chapter about upcoming philanthropy opportunities at chapter

## Monthly

- Schedule call with your regional director
- Write down your steps for the month to help you reach your development goals
- Plan and host a fundraising, volunteering, or awareness event

## Semesterly

- Submit fundraising collected within 72 hours after each event
- Participate in March Madness and BeardsGiving online fundraising events
- Update Philanthropy Chair Development Plan
- Recruit brothers to attend any nearby Ability Camps

## Yearly

- Attend Pi Kapp College for Chapter Officers
- Present to the chapter about Ability Experience Team Events
- Educate associate members about The Ability Experience
- Submit 7 objectives items?
- Apply for Circle of Giving Grant (if qualified) or complete Volunteer Relationship Survey
